ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION:

B.Sc. (Nursing) course:

- 10+2 class passed in science stream (PCBO and English core/English elective with aggregate of 55% marks from recognized board under (AISSCE/CBSE/ICSE/SSCE/HSCE) or other Equivalent Board.
- Both male and female candidates are eligible for admission in B.Sc. Nursing course.
- Minimum age for admissions shall be 17 years.
- Candidate must be medical fit.
- A selection test (CEE) will be conducted by the SSUHS. Candidate must score the cut-off mark or above to get admission to B.Sc. Nursing

Post Basic B.Sc. (Nursing) course :

- Candidate must be a citizen of India.
- Candidate must be medically fit.
- Must passed GNM with 50% from recognized Institute by INC and approved by the State.
- Must be registered with the State Nursing Council.
- A selection test (CEE) will be conducted by the SSUHS. Candidate must score the cut-off mark or above to get admission to Post B.Sc Nursing

General Nursing & Midwifery (GNM) course:

- Both male and female candidates are eligible for admission in GNM course.
- Minimum educational requirement shall be H.S. (10+2) passed from recognized Board (AISSCE /CBSE/ICSE/SSCE/HSCE or other Equivalent Board preferably in science with minimum 45% will be preferred. However, candidates with arts are also eligible to apply.
- Candidates are also eligible from State Open School recognized by State Govt. and National Institute of Open School (NOIS) recognized by Central Govt.
- Candidates must attain the age of 17 years at the time of admission and should not be more than 35 years.
- 5% relaxation is permitted to SC & ST students.
- Students shall be medically fit.
- Registered ANM with pass mark.
- A selection test (GEE) will be conducted by the SSUHS. Candidate must score the cut-off mark or above to get admission to GNM

ANM (Auxiliary Nurses Midwives) Course:

- The minimum age for admission shall be 17 years on or before 31st December of the year in which admission is sought.
- The maximum age for admission shall be 35 years.
- Minimum educational requirement shall be 10+2 in any stream, passing out from a recognized board.
- Students shall be medically fit.
- A selection test (GEE) will be conducted by the SSUHS. Candidate must score the cut-off mark or above to get admission to ANM



BPT (Bachelor in Physiotherapy) Course:

4 years course + 6 month compulsory internship.

- 10+2 passed having English as a subject in science stream with Physics, Chemistry and Biology (PCB) as mandatory subjects with minimum of 60% marks from recognized Board/Council.
- A candidate should have completed the age of 17 years as on 31st December of the year of admission to B.P.T. Degree Course.
- Every candidate must furnish a medical certificate of physical fitness from authorised Government Medical Officer certifying that the candidate is physically fit to undergo the Physiotherapy course before admission.
- Candidates will be accepted with CUET & NEET, CEE Scores for BPT admission.

SCOPE

- Placement in both State and Central Govt. Hospitals and Multi-specialty Hospital in India and abroad, also Working as a clinical Instructor in a Physiotherapy Insitutions.
- Once qualified, a Physiotherapist can work in multispecialty hospitals, rehabilitation centres, in sports and fitness centres, Neurological Rehabilitation Centre, Pediatric Rehabilitation Centre for Special child, Early Intervention care unit for Physiotherapy centre which provide Specialised support and services to young children with disabilities, developmental delays etc., Geriatric Rehabilitation Centre for ealderly people.

They can have 'on the spot study' of employees at work places and provide ergonomic advices to them to avoid physical pain associated with particular posture and type of work.
- Some graduates may like to acquire post graduate qualification in various specializations like Physiotherapy in Musculoskeletal and sports, Neurological conditions, cardio respiratory conditions, Paediatrics & Child Health, Obstetrics and Gynaecology and Community Based Rehabilitation and work as teaching faculties in different institutions of physiotherapy and train the young students in the art and science of physiotherapy.
- Graduates can pursue their job abroad with the fulfilment of eligibility criteria due to its large demand and requirements, and also can work as teachers in different institutions of physiotherapy.





INFRASTRUCTURE:

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Infrastructure is much more important than Architecture

NEPNI is equipped with world class amenities intended to provide a conducive atmosphere for staff and students. The Institute provides the best facilities with suitable environment. The Institute fulfils the requirements of the INC & SSUHS. It has adequate number of spacious, well-ventilated well-lit lecture Halls with comfortable seating arrangements as well as the best laboratories. The entire campus is under CCTV surveillance.

ADMINISTRATIVE BLOCK:

The block is housed in the ground floor of the building with chambers of the honourable Chairman, President, Administrative Officer, Principal (Allied Health Sciences), Admission Cell, HR room, General Office, Faculty Room, Conference Hall equipped with all amenities.



TEACHING BLOCK:

There are sufficient state of art classrooms, demonstration / practical rooms, library, visitors' waiting rooms, computer and audio-visual rooms. Each room is well furnished. At NEPNI, we have well ventilated and furnished spacious Lecture Halls and classrooms with necessary audio-visuals aids for better delivery of teaching by faculties.



LABORATORIES :

As per the norms of Indian Nursing Council, the institute has put in place good laboratory with all equipment and facilities for the students such as –



a) Nursing Foundation Laboratory: It is equipped with all the facilities for practicing the basic procedures of Nursing Foundation and Medical Surgical Nursing. Patient's bed, Manikin, models along with other necessary equipment and articles are available for student's' practice.

b) Community Health Laboratory: This laboratory is constructed for the purpose of learning the basic skills required for Community set-up. Community bags, instruments and articles, models, sample of charts and posters for health teaching etc are available to serve the purpose.



c) OBG and Pediatric Laboratory: All the procedures related to maternal and child health is to be taught in this Laboratory. Provision of Labour Table, Resuscitation equipment, Models and other obstetrical and Gynaecological instruments, paediatric instruments like infant meter, growth assessment charts are available for the students for practicing the basic procedures.

d) Pre-Clinical Science Laboratory: This will be used to instruct the students about Anatomy and Physiology, other biological topics with the specimen and Models for better understanding.



e) Nutrition Laboratory: The nutrition lab is furnished and equipped with work tables, cooking stoves. Gas connections, wash basins with running water supply, cutlery, trays, plates, diet scales, cooking utensils racks, pressure cooker and storage room for all provisional items.

f) Anatomy Laboratory: This lab contain all necessary boneset, skeletons and charts for easy understanding of the subject. The laboratory is well furnished.



g) Physiotherapy Laboratory: Well-equipped physiotherapy lab offers wide range of services for Shoulder, Hand, Knee and Spine, Obesity and Fitness in addition to Incontinence Exercise guidelines and Therapy. Physiotherapy Lab provides the necessary training to meet the total range of patient care responsibilities involved in preventing disabilities and promoting restoration of function to the physically impaired, including Musculoskeletal, Neuromuscular disorders that interfere with the physical function. It includes prescription of Exercise Therapy with the aid of continuous Passive movement device, Electronic




Cervical and Lumbar Traction Unit, Moist Heat Therapy and Paraffin Wax Bath, Manual Therapy, Electrotherapy treatment.



h) Radiography laboratory: Our radiography lab features one mobile X-ray unit, X-ray table with grid facility, X-ray chest stand with required PPE for radiation protection. Students Also have X-ray dark room and various accessories to assist them in learning the proper methods of producing quality radiographs.

i) Microbiology, Pathology and Biochemistry labs: Biochemical, Pathological & Microbiological tests are carried out on clinical specimens to obtain information about the health of a patient to aid in diagnosis, treatment, and prevention of disease.



j) Computer Laboratory: Computer science and Information Technology, which is very essential for students, are to be taught with practical sessions.

LIBRARY HALL :

Our Library is well-furnished and an automated one with reference books / journals with seating capacity of 50 students at a time. Teaching aids and also the reference books are available for faculty members.



AUDIO VISUAL ROOM :



In order to make teaching learning process more attractive, there are audio-visual rooms. Advance training aids like chalk boards, overhead projector, slide, film projectors, modes, specimen, charts posters, photostart machine and computers are provided.

CONFERENCE HALL :

There is provision of a well-equipped Conference Hall with all the modern amenities that will serve the purpose of conferences, meetings and other functions. At times, it will serve the purpose for the Government meetings as and when required.



TRANSPORT :



The institution has its own transport facilities to carry the students from hostel to the institutes and to different hospitals for clinical and practical demonstrations. Students are also provided with transportation for Study Tour, Health Camps, Workshops etc. Weekly transport facility will be provided to the students for the purpose of marketing, amusement and refreshment during holidays.

HOSTEL :

Hostel facility is available for both boy and girl students for the whole period of Study. Students are accommodated in spacious, well-ventilated rooms provided with all the necessary comforts. However, a student may leave the hostel for a short period for attending function at their parent's home and on account of important festivals at home. A full-time warden has been appointed along with support staff including security personnel to look after all the affairs. 24×7 hours electricity and water supply for the hostellers. CCTV has been deployed for round the clock surveillance.



NEPMI CANTEEN :



NEPMI has a spacious canteen on the top floor of the Institute building, having well-furnished dining space and kitchen facility. The canteen serves healthy and hygienic food for students as well as for the teaching and non-teaching staff of the institute.

PLAY GROUND:

There is provision of a play-ground at the institute campus itself so as to enable the students to play various out-door and indoor games.



FIRE EXTINGUISHER :



Fire Extinguishers are provided both at the institute building and the student's hostel.

YOGA & GYMNASIUM FITNESS CENTRE :

The students and staff of NEPNI can devote an hour Each day for fitness activities such as exercise, yoga and meditation. Health Instructor and Motivational Speakers will be invited as and when necessary to address the staff and students.



PSYCHOLOGICAL COUNSELLING CENTRE :



NEPNI provides counselling for students to cope with their psychological issues such as stress, anxiety, speech problem, anger issue, career conflict, domestic violence etc. the counselling centre helps in the overall mental growth of the students making them confident in their lives.

SICK ROOM :

A Sick room in a College is a dedicated space, often called a sick bay or infirmary, where students can rest and receive basic medical care when they are feeling unwell. Rooms are equipped with a bed, first aid supplies and essential medicines to handle minor illnesses and injuries.



RAGGING MENACE

Ragging is a disturbing reality in the higher education system of our country. Despite the fact that over the years, ragging has claimed hundreds of innocent lives and has ruined the careers of thousands of bright students, the practice is still perceived by many as a way of 'familiarisation' and an 'initiation' into the real world for young college-going students.



Ragging is defined as any disorderly conduct, whether by words or written or by any an act, has the effect of teasing, treating, or handling with rudeness a fresher or a junior student. Indulging in a rowdy or undisciplined activity that causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship, or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in a fresher or junior student. Asking the students to do any act or perform something that such students will not do in the ordinary course and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of a fresher or junior student. This can lead to adverse effects such as depression, anxiety, and sometimes even suicide.

Punishment provisions :

Any student or group of students found guilty of ragging on campus or off campus shall be liable to one or more of the following punishments:

1. Debarring from appearing from any sessional test/ university examination or withholding results.
2. Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.
3. Withdrawing scholarships and other benefits.
4. Suspension from the college for a period of one month.
5. Cancellation of admission.
6. Debarring from representing the institution in any national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
7. Suspension/ expulsion from the hostel.
8. Rustication from the institution for periods varying from 1 to 4 semester or equivalent period.
9. Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution.
10. To fine upto ₹ 25,000/- (twenty five thousand only).
11. Imprisonment for a time which may extend to 2 years or with fine, which may extend to ₹ 10,000/- (ten thousand only) or both.
12. Collective punishment – when the students committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment as a deterrent to ensure community pressure on the potential raggers.
 - Any institution that fails to take adequate steps to prevent ragging or fails to act in accordance with the Regulations or fails to punish perpetrators or incidence of ragging suitably liable to the penalties and punishments as per the provisions of the Regulations

DRESS CODE:

The significant importance of uniforms is to give a sense of equality. Wearing an uniform reduces absenteeism, promotes their attendance, pays attention to their studies and instils a lot of discipline, focus and good behaviour.

To identify as a student of NEPNI, uniform is mandatory. The students wear uniforms both at the institute as well as during their clinical postings. Uniforms are provided separately for theory classes, community and clinical postings for both boys and girls. Special dress for posting in the ICU, OT, labour room and NICU are provided to the students as and when necessary. Sweater, shoes and socks are also provided along with the uniform.



GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS:

General:

- Tampering with the campus belongings, replacing the furnitures or exercising authority over the Institution employees is not allowed.

Discipline:

- Ragging is strictly prohibited as per order from Hon'ble Supreme Court.
- Complete silence is to be maintained during class hours.
- Mobile phones are strictly prohibited during class and clinical duty hours
- Consumption and possession of alcoholic drinks, chewing tobacco, smoking etc. is strictly forbidden.
- Possession of unauthorized cash, valuables or ornaments is not allowed. The management shall not be responsible for any loss or theft of valuables.
- All complaints should be registered through proper channel. Students should maintain peace, harmony, integrity and discipline during their stay in the institution and hostel.

Grievance Redresal

- All the students must obey all rules set by faculty and the management.
- All the students must engage in lectures, practical sessions and discussions with full attention.
- Student can lodge their grievance through institute website or through manual system for which complaint boxes are placed in the institution.

Cleanliness:

- Keep the classrooms and surroundings clean and hygenic.
- Eating or drinking inside the classroom is not allowed.
- Sticking of posters and photos on the wall in not allowed.

Maintenance:

- For any breakage or damage caused by student, the management has the right to deduct equal amount of money from the security deposit.

Others:

- After the completion of course/internship, students are required to submit their respective Identity-cards to their respective and concerned Principal(s). All other belongings including library books, equipments etc., should be handed over to the management before leaving the Institute.
- A hostel boarder cannot leave the hostel during the session. If anyone leaves the hostel, he/she has to pay the hostel rent (₹3500) till the session ends

Dismissal:

Students are liable for immediate dismissal in case of:

- Any kind of misconduct within or outside the Institute.

- Disobeying the rules and regulations of the Institution.
- Absence from school/college for a very long period of time without intimation.
- Interference with the decisions of the management concerning matters related to smooth administration.

Vacations:

- Students will be granted 30 days annual leave, 10 days sick and 7 days preparatory leave.

Leave rules:

- Students are not allowed to stay out overnight without permission and will be suspended from the institution if found doing so.
- Students must reach on time from leave otherwise necessary action will be taken against the student.

Healthcare has now been a primary focus of the Govt. both at state and central level, putting lot of efforts in terms of setting more infrastructures across the country, coupled with deployment of huge manpower. The private sector is also not lagging behind in this regard. It appears that there is still a large section of people of the country, particularly belonging to North Eastern states of the country facing problems in getting proper health care. Guwahati has become the hub of treatment for people coming from the entire North Eastern states. Patients throng to Guwahati based Hospitals to get better treatment. Most of them fly to Chennai, New Delhi, Hyderabad, Bengaluru, Mumbai with the perception that the facilities are better there than they are in Guwahati.
